## Abstract:

The collection is organized into two series:

The first series of photographs is organized by street numbers and addresses. Earlier photographs are shown first with the later photograph after to show the more recent status to the properties.

The early pictures, taken between 1940-1970, were commissioned by the city of Chicago and were taken by Copelin Photographers. The photographs are 8x10 prints in black and white format. These shots documented dangerous/condemned structures throughout the city. The City of Chicago then used these photographs to authorize renovation, development, or demolition of these properties.

The later pictures were taken by James S. Parker between 2000-2002 on a 35mm camera. Parker returned to these properties to document what happened to these specific locations. Some of the properties were turned into new housing, parks, schools, and churches. However, many of the pictures taken by Parker show that much of the land was left undeveloped as vacant land lots after the properties were demolished.

Overall, these photographs illustrate how policy, economic conditions, and urban renewal influenced the changing of demographics in the Bronzeville community.

The second series is an Excel worksheet that provides footnotes on addresses and properties near notable events and residences in the Bronzeville community.

## **Biographical/Historical Note:**

James S. Parker was born April 24, 1940, in Chicago, Illinois. Parker grew up at 4124 W Fletcher, Chicago, IL. Parker attended Scammon Public elementary school. In 1958, Parker graduated from Lane Technical High School. Parker attended Illinois Wesleyan University and completed a bachelor's degree in 1963.

In 1959, Parker married his first wife Karen, 5 children. Together they also fostered several children over the years. They formally adopted 2 of their foster children. The couple divorced in the early 1970s.

Parker worked for the city between 1963-1971 for the Clerk's office and the Bureau of Electricity. Parker purchased and co-owned, with Leo Newman, Copelin Photographers. Copelin Photographers, which was established in 1856 and was located at 309 West Madison in Chicago, IL. Between 1972-1992, Parker worked as a political aide to Congressman Frank Annunzio.

Parker was involved with the North Branch Coalition and lead several marches throughout the city for environmental causes. He was a member of the North Branch River Coalition and supported efforts to keep the Chicago River clean.

Parker met his second wife CeCe in 1976 and the two were soon married. Together the couple had two children. Now Parker has 14 grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild. Parker currently resides on the northside of Chicago.

James S. Parker is a lifetime member at the Bronzeville Historical Society and contributed greatly to the Society's holdings. Parker provided a searchable Bronzeville property database listing more than 300 specific homes and streetscapes in alphabetical order. He also donated more than 1,500 images detailing Bronzeville community buildings and streetscapes from the 1950's to 1999. Parker is a continued advocate who showed support to the Bronzeville Historical Society when located at the Stephen A. Douglas Tomb State Historic Site.

The first series is "Photographs" and consists of four 3-ring binders that are organized in by street number and address. Photographs with dates and annotations are in alphabetical order.
